



COVID-19 Pandemic Protocol

As we reopen for the school year 2020-2021 Campus Kid's main goal, as always, is to make sure the health, safety and well-being of our students, family members and staff is a priority. The Center for Disease Control and Texas Health and Human Services Commission has published guidelines and protocol for the COVID-19 pandemic. We will monitor these organizations and implement the following procedures as necessary until they determine that COVID-19 is no longer a danger to our students, families and staff. Remember that prevention is the way to get rid of this disease.

Training: All staff will train for COVID-19 before the 1st day of work

- 1) Cleaning and Disinfecting equipment and facility
- 2) Wearing PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)
- 3) COVID-19 prevention
- 4) Protecting Yourself and Others from COVID-19
- 5) All staff will complete: THHSC training Through Texas A&M AgrilLife website

Arrival and Sign In: Screening

- 1) Make sure before arrival your child does not have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, muscle aches, chills, sore throat or any other symptom of COVID-19. If a student or staff arrive with any symptoms they will be sent home.
- 2) The temperature of each student and staff member will be taken outside each day with a contact free thermometer before entering the program. Temperature over 100.4 is considered a fever and they will not be allowed into the building.

- 3) All staff and students will wash hands or use sanitizer before entering the building. Parents will not be allowed to enter the school building.
- 4) Sign in will take place outside of the building

Dismissal and Sign Out:

- 1) Upon arrival to pick up their child, parents will have to wait outside the cafeteria doors. Parents will sign their children out outside the cafeteria doors. Payments will also be made outside the cafeteria doors.
- 2) If for some reason they must come in the building, their temperature will be taken, they will use hand sanitizer and wear a mask.

Program Safety:

- 1) Staff will wear gloves when handling snacks, taking temperature, using cleaning utensils and supplies and for any other necessary purpose.
- 2) Face masks will be worn according to school district protocol
- 3) Hand washing: Staff and students will wash hands after using restroom, before and after snack, before rotating, after sneezing or any time deemed necessary. We will make sure hands stay clean.
If for some reason we cannot wash hands we will use hand sanitizer applied by staff.
- 4) All supplies, toys, surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected on a regular basis with disinfectant registered with EPA. All application instructions will be followed.
- 5) Cleaning supplies, disinfectant and hand sanitizer will be properly labeled kept out of reach of children.
- 6) Spacing: Children will be seated with proper spacing while in the cafeteria. Smaller groups will be utilized inside and outside to allow for social distancing.
- 7) If a student or staff member tests positive to the COVID virus school administration will be informed immediately. We will stay in constant communication with school administration.
- 8) All staff will understand the risk involved in working in a child care setting.
